

St James' Nursery Admissions Criteria

Our admission of children complies with relevant equalities and non-discriminatory legislation

Admission criteria are used to allocate places when the number of applications for a school exceeds the number of places available. The admission criteria for our Nursery:

- Looked after children and previously looked after children.
- Children with an EHC of Special Educational Needs, which names the school.
- Children whose older brothers or sisters attend St James' CofE and will still be

here at the time of admission.

- Children living closest to the schools.
- Children eligible to receive Government funding (proof of eligibility will be required).

We can take a maximum of 24 children. This is split into

- 12 x 15hour morning places.
- 12 x 15hour afternoon places.
- Any additional sessions will then be allocated. Additional sessions will only be

allocated where there is availability and/or where they do not take up a full time

place. There is no lunchtime provision in our nursery.

In the event of oversubscription children will be put onto a waiting list. They will then

be allocated places using the following criteria:

- By date of application

Applications are available from the school office. There is no guarantee that a nursery

place will result in a child accessing a place in pre-school or school.

Poor attendance may result in a child losing their place.

The Headteacher has the final decision. If you wish to appeal a decision made please

speak to the Headteacher.
