All you have to do is:

- 5. Please do not arrive before 4pm unless another time is shown in the rally book, to give the marshal time to prepare for your arrival.

Stop at the Rally Marshals caravan, this is usually the first van near the entrance & has a Rally Marshal sign outside. Here you will be welcomed & given general information, such as where the fresh water tap is & the elsan disposal, much as you would find on any site
