Directions to the Douglas County Fairgrounds

Exit I-25 either southbound or northbound at Castle Rock exit 181 (Plum Creek Parkway going east).

Follow Plum Creek Parkway (approximately 1 mile), turn left (North) at Fairgrounds Drive and follow road North to indoor events center located to the west of the main building.

Use Gate E to enter arena. Parking is available on the East and West ends of building.

Crating and Exercising Dogs

A crating area is available in the vicinity of the ring.

Competitors are required to pick up after their dogs. Do not allow dogs to urinate inside the building, or outside on any man-movable objects such as trash cans.

Dogs are required to be leashed or crated at all times, except when competing in the ring or using the warm-up jump. Failure to comply with these rules will result in refusal of entries to future FRAT events.

RV and Camping at Douglas County Fairgrounds

ONLY designated areas MUST be used for any event parking, camping or RV's at a Douglas County facility.

There are 20 spaces with electrical hook-ups available for \$15/night. No water or sewer hook-ups are available. A sanitary sewer dump station is not available.

Spaces will be assigned on a first paid basis.

Reservations for electric and dry camping must be made in advance. No charge for dry camping in designated areas, exhaust diverters required.

The arena will not be setup until 7 a.m. Friday morning. However, RVs will be permitted to stay Thursday night if desired.

Please do not park before 5 p.m. The arena will not be available for use until Friday a.m. Please plan accordingly.

Concessions

Depending on the number of contestants participating each day, there may not be a food concessionaire on site. There are quick service restaurants near the trial site.

Everyone is welcome to bring their own food and beverages. Lunches will be provided for trial workers. Check your final confirmation for details regarding concessions.

Check-in & Measuring

Dog Measurements & Certification

All dogs not jumping 24" in the Championship Program or 20" in the Performance Program at local and regional events must be measured unless they have permanent USDAA or World Cynosport Dog Registration status or a temporary card with 3 signatures as required by the regulations, making the dog eligible for their jump height (prior to 3 years of age). Please note that only dogs 18 months of age and entered in the event may be officially measured.

A Dog that Measures Up at Check-In - May Run FEO

If a judge's measurement of a dog at check-in establishes that the dog is ineligible for the height class in which entered, the competitor may

- Run the dog at the higher height in the same program based upon the measurement,
- Modify the entry to enroll the dog in the proper height class in the Performance Program,
- Modify the entry to enroll the dog in the proper height class in the Veterans Program if the dog is 8 years old
- Run For Exhibition Only (FEO) at the next lowest jump height, but only in the program entered.

Because entry into a higher height is permitted in the Performance and Championship Programs, a dog measuring lower may not be moved to a lower height in either program.

Tentative Class Running Order

On Friday TEAM/PVP & M/P3/V Snooker will be run in random height order - Championship then performance.

Saturday's classes will run small to tall (Performance followed by Championship).

Sunday will run tall to small (M/P3/V Snooker will be randomized); Championship then Performance.

Entries & Acceptance

No Entry For Exhibition Only

No entry "For Exhibition Only" shall be accepted, except as provided for in Chapter 10 when Intro Program classes are offered. See additional note for club policy regarding dogs that measure up.

General Rule on Eligibility

This event is sanctioned by the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. ("USDAA").

This test is open to all persons with dogs being at least 18 months of age (14 months of age pursuant to Chapter 10 for Intro Program when offered OR for Sanctioned Match), regardless of pedigree or absence thereof, who have a current registration with USDAA and whose owners and the dog's handler are currently in good standing with USDAA.

This event will be held under USDAA® Official Rules and Regulations, a copy of which may be viewed and printed online at [USDAA Rules & Regulations](#), as amended.

Policy on Refusal of Entry

The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the Committee view that participation by the competitor or dog could be prejudicial to the sport. However, in such case, the Committee must notify the competitor in writing upon receipt of entry, but in no case, more than three days following the event closing date for acceptance of entries. The burden of responsibility for the appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.

NSF Check/Credit Card

Any check or credit card that is charged back by the bank or other financial institution may be assessed a service charge of up to \$40 per incident at the discretion of the host group.

Returned checks or credit card returns do not constitute a valid entry. Amounts shall be paid within 30 day of postmarked notice of the returned payment if such date follows the event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice will result in cancellation of event results for all classes related to the entry for which payment was made. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution.

Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event, or entry is canceled without recourse.

Refund Policy

There shall be NO REFUNDS for entries withdrawn after the closing date for acceptance of entries, for absentee, dismissal from the event as a result of disciplinary action, dismissal from a class, or for any other reason. Also, no entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, acts of terrorism, fire, "act of God", public emergency, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the host organization.

Submission of Entries with Secondary Move-Up Date

All entries or cancellations must be received at the Secretary's address no later than the closing date, after which time no entries will be accepted or cancelled. For entries received by the closing date, the level of entry into a given class may be advanced by notifying the Secretary in writing via email by the "Secondary Closing Date". No other changes, cancellations or additions may be made after the initial closing date.

To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date and accompanied by the correct fees and include a valid USDAA registration number on a completed registration form.

Next-Day Move-Ups Allowed At This Event

Competitors earning a qualification during the Event that is needed to complete a title may advance their level THE NEXT DAY at the same event, i.e. move-ups on consecutive days ARE allowed.

Competitors are responsible for keeping accurate records of their qualifying scores and the judges from whom these scores were earned prior to this event to ensure that the dog is eligible to move up based upon scores earned at this Event. Competitors are advised to confirm scores earned with the scorekeeper and judge at the conclusion of a class to ensure the qualifying score has been accurately calculated and awarded in accordance with regulations. If for any reason it is determined that the score or previous scores were inaccurate, making the entry ineligible for the higher level class, any results (including awards) shall be forfeited and the entry will be deemed invalid without refund or other recourse.

Move-up forms supplied by this event must be used to notify the secretary BEFORE she leaves the site the day on which you earn your title.

BIS Allowed at this Event

Bitches in season will be allowed at this event per the USDAA Bitches in Season policy. They must wear sanitary britches (panties) at all times and will be crated separately. No adjustment in the running order will be made. The club will require panties to be worn at all times except while in the potty area outside. Handlers should become familiar with the new policy and should be prepared to follow it at all times. The club also requests handlers with BIS pay particular attention to the following paragraph from the USDAA policy. "BIS is a good faith policy to provide all handlers the opportunity to compete. Handlers choosing to compete with a BIS should provide consideration to their dog's condition and temperament and the impact on others it might have in determining whether they should participate with a BIS. In so doing, they must at all times be respectful to the show committee and fellow competitors."

If a competitor chooses not to run their dog due to being in season, refunds will follow the refund policy for injury/illness listed below.

Refunds for Bitch in Season, Injury, or Illness

Withdrawal of a bitch that comes into season after the closing date is eligible for a 50% refund (vet letter not required.) Withdrawal due to injury or illness after the closing date is eligible for a 50% voucher for entry at future FRAT USDAA trials provided a veterinarian's letter is provided within one week of the trial. In such instances the secretary MUST be notified by phone or e-mail, no later than Thursday, February 27 at 8:00 a.m. False reports warrant refusal of entries at future FRAT trials. Any other withdrawals after the closing date will not be eligible for refund.

FRAT Refund Policy

There will be no refunds under \$5.00 for overpayment of entry fees.

Refunds for Moveups to Unscheduled Class

Refunds will not be given for a moveup that advances the team to a class that is not offered on that day of competition.

FRAT Returned Checks Policy

There is a \$30.00 service charge for returned checks. Payment of entry fees and service charges for returned checks shall be made in cash or money order before checking in at the event.

Media Release & Rights of Privacy Waiver

Media Rights Release

I HEREBY GRANT TO USDAA and its affiliated companies, representatives, agents and assigns, all rights and permission to use or appropriate his/her and their dog's name, biography, likeness, photograph, voice, performing persona, or other indicia of identity for broadcast, telecast, cablecast, transmission or distribution in any format or media known now or in the future.

Waiver of Rights to Privacy, Publicity & Personality

FURTHER, I HEREBY RELEASE United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. and its affiliates, representatives, agents and assigns from any claim or cause of action for invasion of the rights of privacy, right of publicity, right of personality, or any similar right.

General Entry Conditions

Prohibitions on Aids & Devices

No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time, except as provided for in Chapter 10 when Intro Program classes are offered, or in Chapter 8 when Junior Handler Program classes are offered.

Statement of Responsibility

Competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of themselves, their dogs, children, and guests. A competitor whose dogs, children or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Organizing Committee, be asked to leave the test site.

Policy on Fault Limits

In the event of a larger entry, fault limits may be set at the discretion of the Organizing Committee and/or Judge without pre-event notice.

Spam Blocker

Confirmations will be sent via email using the secretary's address. If you have a spam blocker on your email account, please configure it to allow email from the secretary's address since confirmations will be sent from this account.

Fix & Continue Will Be Allowed At This Event

The USDAA Policy Statement on Training in the Ring or "Fix & Continue" has been adopted for this event and is hereby incorporated in its entirety by reference. Competitors are expected to familiarize themselves with this policy, which can be found on the USDAA web site at [Official USDAA Policy Statements](#)

Fix & Continue during a competition run generally provides for repeat of an obstacle at handler's discretion under conditions set forth in the Policy Statement. When discretion is exercised to utilize the Fix & Continue, their score will be recorded as an elimination and the maximum course time set to 60 seconds. This practice may be utilized only once in any Standard, Jumpers, or Relay class (including similarly-styled tournament classes at qualifying events). The competitor must continue working the course in flow, while "fixing" and "continuing" on the course. See the Policy Statement referenced above for complete details.

Class Descriptions

Titling Class Rules & Descriptions

One or more titling classes shall be held at this Event from those described in Chapters 3 - 8 of USDAA Official Rules & Regulations, which are downloadable from www.usdaa.com/regulations/usdaa-rules-and-regulations.cfm, and any amendments there to, which are hereby incorporated by reference.

Tournament Class Rules & Descriptions

One or more tournament classes are being held at this event, the rules and description of which may be downloaded on the Internet at [Tournament Regulations](#), and are hereby incorporated by reference. A written copy may be obtained from the Event secretary.

Mixed-Height Pairs Entry Allowed

Dogs entered as partners in pairs relay at this event may be combined without regard to jump height, i.e. a mini dog may be entered as a partner with an open dog. Any pair consisting of at least one open dog must qualify in accordance with the QCT set forth by the judge of record for Open Pairs AND will be considered an open pair for placement purposes.

Veterans Program Classes

Veterans level classes offered at this event are open to a competitor with any dog that is at least eight (8) years of age as of the first day of this event. Previous experience in the sport sufficient to establish proficiency and confidence in performance is strongly encouraged. A dog entered in a Veterans class on a day may not be entered in that class in the Championship or Performance Programs. Complete program rules can be found at [USDAA Rules & Regulations](#) including amendments.

Team & Versatility Pairs Measure-up Policy

The handler of a dog entered in Team or Versatility Pairs must notify the secretary immediately should their dog be required to jump a higher height by virtue of the judge's measurement. The dog must jump the higher jump height in order to be eligible to earn a qualifying score in the tournament. If entered in Team, the dog that measured up may be moved to Versatility Pairs. If the handler chooses **not** to have their dog jump the higher height or move to PVP, their entry is effectively withdrawn. The competitor may or may not run for exhibition only (earning no individual class qualifications or tournament qualification for the team) solely at the discretion of the event secretary; there shall be no refund of fees paid.

If the change in height makes the dog ineligible for their team (three jump heights), the secretary will make every effort to form complete teams from dogs available. A move-up in height for dogs in Versatility Pairs does not affect their team composition, but may result in a change in their position in the running order because of the height composition of the Pair.

Masters Challenge Biathlon - Concurrent Titling Scores

The Masters Challenge (MC) & Performance Masters Challenge (PMC) Biathlon tournaments each consists of two classes; Standard and Jumpers. In addition to the combined score of these two classes being scored for tournament qualification purposes, each class will be scored independently in order to determine if title qualification has been earned for the MC and PMC standard and jumpers classes.

Mulligan Runs

Based upon the number of runs per day at this trial Mulligan Runs may be available for one or more classes each day. The Show Committee shall determine in which class(es) a Mulligan Run will be allowed. Availability and cost for each run shall be announced in final confirmations. Only competitors entered in the class are eligible for a Mulligan Run per USDAA policy which is hereby incorporated by reference.

A competitor must sign up and pay for their Mulligan Run immediately following their titling run (if they didn't sign up/pay for a Mulligan Run prior) and prior to the completion of the class. A Mulligan Run sign-up sheet will be made available. When Mulligans are running concurrently with another ring at an event, only silent toys are allowed and may not be tossed. Food, treats, training aids are not allowed.

Prizes & Awards

Titling Class & Tournament Awards

TITLING CLASSES:

Standard and Non-standard Classes: Separate first through third place ribbons will be awarded for each jump height classification. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to those dogs earning qualifying scores.

Pairs: Awards will be made to mini (Ch. 12/14/16/18, Perf. 8/12) and open (Ch 22/26, Perf. 16/20) divisions. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to those dogs earning qualifying scores.

Titles: Titling rosettes will be awarded to those dogs completing a title at the trial.

TOURNAMENT CLASSES:

Grand Prix / Performance Grand Prix: Separate first through third place ribbons will be awarded for each jump height classification. In addition, the first place qualifying team in each height class will earn a regional bye voucher. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all qualifiers.

M/P Biathlon: Separate first through third place ribbons will be awarded for each jump height classification. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all qualifiers.

Steeplechase/PSJ: Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all qualifiers in Round 1. Details regarding prize money offered for Round 2 can be found in the class descriptions at the USDAA website.

Team / Versatility Pairs: All qualifying teams/pairs will receive FRAT dog tags in recognition of their qualification. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams/pairs members will receive FRAT medals for the respective Team/PVP placements.
