NTDA Executive Council Member to climb Mount Everest for Wooden Spoon Charity

Simon will join 30 other Wooden Spoon supporters to tackle Everest, ascending to Advanced base camp and beyond with the aim of raising in excess of £200,000 for this fantastic charity. He will be funding his own costs and 100% of any money donated will go directly to the Wooden Spoon.

The LMAX Exchange Everest Rugby Challenge takes place across 24 days (13 April to 6 May 2019) and will see the group battle acclimatisation and heights of 6,500 metres to play the highest

game of full contact rugby and the highest game of mixed touch rugby in history – two new Guinness World Records.

The Wooden Spoon is the children's charity of rugby https://woodenspoon.org.uk it funds life-changing projects across the UK and Ireland to support children and young people with disabilities or facing disadvantage. Its vision is that every child and young person, no matter what their background, has access to the same opportunities. It funds a huge range
