Application Method:	Tractor sprayer

EXPERIMENT - TREATMENTS

Black Earth was applied at one (1) gallon per acre on soil surface and compared to an untreated check; all other parameters being equal.


Treatment	Yield (bu/acre)	% Protein	Net value/ acre	Treatment cost	Difference/ acre
Black Earth	133	10.8	\$432.50	\$9.75	\$21.05
Check	123.6	10.5	\$401.70	_	_
