



Q1: Please indicate your primary business sector











Q5: Due to COVID-19, what changes have you made to your hours of operation?






Q7: What amount of your workforce has transitioned to working remotely?



Q8: If you are a restaurant, are you offering take out/delivery during this time?





Q9: If you are a retailer, are you offering curbside/delivery of orders?





Q10: Have you seen changes in sales due to COVID 19?






Q12: If you applied for EIDL (Economic Injury Disaster Loan), have you received funding?




