ATZARO, IBIZA Week from £349pp

It's more yummy yogi than party animal at this family-run farmhouse in an orange grove in the northeast of Ibiza. The ambience is slow-paced, but things speed up in the new fitness club — it offers free highintensity interval training and muscle building, as well as gentler classes such as yoga and stretching. The Balinese day beds dotted through the vast gardens are ideal for a post-workout snooze. Or you can snore your way through a massage at the alfresco spa for an extra charge. And it won't all go wrong at meal times — La Veranda restaurant serves

nutritionally balanced, locally sourced dishes.

A week starts at £349pp, B&B, including fitness classes and use of the sauna and hammam (00 34 971 338838, atzaro.com). Fly to Ibiza with British Airways or Ryanair

LA MANGA CLUB, SPAIN Week from £569pp

Europe's best-known sports resort is a favourite of Premier League teams, but La Manga, an hour outside Alicante, still scores for value, particularly if you stay in one of its smart apartments, rather than the main hotel. Your room key gives access to a fitness centre, sauna and steam rooms, three golf courses, 28 tennis courts and eight football pitches, where elite players including David Beckham have trained. Lovely hill walking, wide beaches and a saltwater lagoon are all nearby, too. A week starts at £569pp, half-board, including flights from London and a daily

ZENING, CYPRUS Week from £575pp
