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## Environmental Statement

The Directors and managers of Complete Demolition Limited acknowledge that its undertakings have an impact on the environment. We are committed to reducing that impact by seeking continual improvement. This will be achieved by carrying out our operations to a clear and consistent policy for protection of the environment.

Specifically we aim to:

- Comply with relevant environmental legislation and government guidelines
- Adopt reasonable measures to prevent water, air, ground or noise pollution
- Make efficient use of modern plant and techniques to reduce waste, using the waste hierarchy in all instances
- Ensure that all our workers have a good understanding of how our business may affect the environment and what is expected of them to help minimise this impact.
- Communicate with our neighbours and manage our operations in a manner that causes minimum disruption and has minimum impact on the local environment including plants, wildlife and waterways;
- Involve all of our suppliers in the implementation of this policy.

In particular we will reduce our environmental impact by improvements in:

- Raising the environmental awareness of our site operatives and suppliers through induction and training.
- Ensure dust is kept to a minimum by using damping down methods;
- Use modern, well-maintained transport, plant and equipment that are fuel-efficient and reduce emissions and unnecessary travel.
- Seeking to reduce the waste produced on site, segregating waste streams and separating demolition materials into component parts.
- Ensuring our waste disposal sites have the correct permits for the waste they receive from us.
- Seeking to reduce vehicle carbon dioxide emissions, and energy and water consumption.
- Ensure noise pollution is reduced by ensuring plant, tools and equipment are adequately silenced and regularly maintained;

We will aim for continual improvement of our environmental performance through effective communication, provision of staff training and adoption of best available techniques.

The Directors and Management will monitor compliance with this policy which will be reviewed once a year.
