

KINGSTON UPON HULL SWIMMING CLUB Child Supervision Policy

- Swimmers under the age of 12 should have an adult responsible for them in the building whilst they are in training sessions.
- We understand that occasionally it will be necessary to leave the building whilst your children are swimming, if this is the case, please inform the squad manager or the coach of the alternative supervision arrangements.
- We must stress that it is important that you, or a nominated individual, are available during training sessions in the event of an emergency. Coaches are there to coach and not to be responsible for child care.
- Swimmers should be accompanied into the building and not dropped off outside so as to avoid any confusion as to who is in attendance.
- Siblings who are not swimming must be supervised at all times and not left to wander around at poolside or anywhere on the premises of the facilities used by the club. Their behaviour should not endanger the safety of others or themselves and not bring the reputation of the club into disrepute.
- Children who are not swimming should not be at poolside during galas.
- Parents should ensure that children who are not swimming in a gala remain in the viewing area and not at poolside unless they are helping in an official capacity.

Please remember that you have responsibility for the health, safety and well being of swimmers and siblings.
