## **Ambulatory Surgery Center Engagement**

### **Community Advisory Group**

- The Community Advisory Group held its first meeting on November 14, next meeting December 10.
- Currently 10 members, 6 total community members.
- The group discussed and agreed to include one more abutter.
- An important topic discussed by the group was experiences and accessibility for patients.
- This is a volunteer group to help us work through this process; this group augments community engagement, and does not replace any public meetings.

## **Emergency Department Closure**

- Factors and data that led to the decision
  - Least used ED in the state.
  - 7 other EDs within 2-6 miles. In a life-threatening emergency always call 911.
- Expanding Urgent Care
  - Expansion of urgent care: new hours will be 7 a.m. to 11 p.m., seven days a week.
  - Only urgent care in the area with these extended early morning and late night hours.
  - Will be promoted through informational campaign.
- Timeline and Process
  - Notified DPH and announced publically on November 7, 2018.
  - Expect to file on December 7, 2018 with DPH.
  - Starts 90-day DPH review process.
  - Public comment and public hearing early January, to be set by DPH.
