<u>Cadet Applicant:</u> Please give this "Mentor Application" to someone that you trust and look up to, someone who will be a friend, role model and positive influence. Please go to our website <a href="https://www.nmyca.net">www.nmyca.net</a> and click on the "Mentor" tab at the top of the page to watch a short video on "How to nominate a mentor."

<u>The prospective mentor should be:</u> A legal resident of New Mexico, at least 21 years old, employed, in school or retired; a good role model; the same gender as cadet; live within 50 miles as cadet; someone who demonstrates, by example, the type of life skills, work ethics and attitudes needed to be a productive member of society.

<u>The prospective mentor may not be</u>: Living in the same household as the cadet; parent/guardian of cadet's boyfriend/girlfriend; boyfriend/girlfriend or spouse of cadet's parent/guardian. May be a family member, however relationship should not affect cadet/mentor relationship or relationship with the rest of the family. Suggestions for good mentors: teachers, counselors, coaches, ministers/pastors; military, etc.

Mentor Applicant: Thank you for considering being a mentor for a NM National Guard Youth ChalleNGe Academy Applicant. The rewards are well worth the time involved. It is a serious commitment, so we ask that you think this decision over carefully. Please visit our website to get more information about being a mentor, or call the Mentor Coordinator to get answers to any questions you may have. This application requires a lot of personal information. The required information is to do a thorough back ground check before matching cadets with mentors. Youthful indiscretions or some legal involvement will not necessarily disqualify you from being a mentor. We understand that mistakes are made and as long as you do not withhold information, your application will be considered. Prospective mentors are also required to provide a copy of a valid driver's license and current auto insurance.

Your complete application can be turned in with the cadet application and can be placed in a sealed envelope, to ensure privacy is kept. Again, thank you for considering being a mentor!

# Statement of Understanding

(Sign and return with completed application)

NM National Guard Youth ChalleNGe Academy (NMNGYCA) is a unique opportunity for the youth of NM, ages16-18 who are struggling in school or who have already dropped out of school. It truly is a "second chance" to turn their lives around. A very important part of our program is the involvement of mentors. When a cadet has a mentor who is committed to help him/her succeed, he or she is much more likely to finish the program and return to his/her community as a productive citizen. We all know that your time is precious, but this opportunity is life changing......for both of you. Please call if you need more information. Here is a brief description of what is involved in the Mentor Program at NMNGYCA.

- Each cadet must provide ONE complete mentor application to be considered for acceptance into the program. The mentor application must be submitted with the cadet's application. A "friendly match" is highly recommended. This is where the applicant and prospective mentor know each other.
- Once an applicant is ACCEPTED, the prospective mentor will be subject to a state and federal background check.
- The prospective mentor is **REQUIRED** to attend mentor training, which is held in Roswell. Training is **mandatory** and happens after the cadet is accepted to NGYCA.
- Mentors and cadets must communicate during the Residential Phase. Cadets will write letters to mentors weekly and mentors are encouraged to respond as soon as letters are received.
- Once cadets and mentors have been trained, mentors are allowed to schedule visits with their cadets. VISITS ARE NOT MANDATORY, but highly encouraged. If you cannot schedule a visit with your cadet, please ensure that you are maintaining contact.
- Prior to completing the Residential Phase, cadets will develop a Post-Residential Action Plan (P-RAP), which will outline what the cadet wants to do after the Residential Phase. Mentors will get a copy of their cadet's P-RAP at mentor training and are encouraged to revisit this document regularly when talking with their cadet to ensure that progress is being made.
- The mentor must live within a 50 mile radius of their cadet. This is to be able to maintain effective communication and continue to build a strong, lasting relationship. Once the cadet completes the Residential Phase, the requirement is that you attempt a minimum of 4 hours of contact with your cadet. These contacts can be in any form, face to face, phone, etc. The total period of responsibility is 14 months, 2 months during the Residential Phase and the 12 month Post-Residential Phase.
- Mentors play an important role encouraging their cadet to enroll in school, get a job, and stay
  on the path they have set for themselves in their P-RAP.
- The mentor is also required to send a monthly report to the NMYCA Case Manager for the 12 month Post-Residential Phase. You will be advised during training of the methods of reporting as well as the deadlines that need to be met.
