The Japan Rail Pass is a discount ticket allowing unlimited rail travel throughout Japan over a 7, 14 or 21 consecutive day period. It is available in either an Ordinary (coach class) or Green (first class) version. Because Japan Railways has 12,400 miles of track, it is possible to travel almost anywhere in the country by train. The Japan Rail Pass can provide you with convenience and great savings if used wisely, but it is a discount ticket and some restrictions on trains do apply. There are no restrictions on date or season.

**Remark:** The JAPAN RAIL PASS offers an incredibly economical way to travel throughout Japan by rail. Please be aware, however, that some restrictions apply. The pass is not valid for "NOZOMI" and "MIZUHO" trains on the Tokaido, Sanyo and Kyushu Shinkansen lines

## For passengers entering Japan using a non-Japanese passport

The Japan Rail Pass is only available for holders of a valid 'Temporary Visitor' entry status stamp within their passport. Passport holders from the following countries will automatically receive this stamp on arrival into Japan if entering for 90 days or less of non-paid activity (e.g. tourism, visiting friends or relatives, meetings, conferences etc):

U.S.A., United Kingdom (UK citizens only), Andorra, Argentina, Australia, Austria, Bahamas, Belgium, Bulgaria, Canada, Chile, Costa Rica, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Rep., Denmark, Dominican Rep., El Salvador, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Guatemala, Honduras, Hong Kong (SAR), Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Macedonia, Malta, Mauritius, Mexico, Monaco, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Rep. of Korea, Romania, San Marino, Singapore, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Suriname, Sweden, Switzerland, Tunisia, Turkey and Uruguay.

If the passenger's country is not included in this list they should apply for a 'Temporary Visitor' visa before they travel to Japan if they wish to use the Japan Rail Pass. Please see the visa guide at the Japanese Ministry of Foreign Affairs for more information on the visa applications procedure.
