RATE CHARGES: All tariffs quoted are subject to change, without prior notice, however rate's quoted for confirmed booking will be honoured. **RATES INCLUDE:** Luxury accommodation. Two games drives per day. Optional walking safaris.

RATES EXCLUDE: All food and beverage (you bring your own). Staff gratuities. Sabi Sands entry fees and conservation levy.

ACCOMMODATION: VUYATELA LODGE

The camp is an exclusive, private camp, self-catered and fully serviced. All food and beverage requirements should be supplied by the guests. Vuyatela's rate is inclusive of a chef who will prepare the food you supply. **Suites:** All five suites comprise bedroom, dressing-room, bathroom, separate lounge, private teak deck, air conditioning, fan, mosquito net. **Main Lodge:** Includes a large double deck flowing onto a swimming pool, outdoor dining, bar overlooking the watering hole, suspended bird watching tower, a library and relaxation room. Internet access. Open vehicle game drives and walking safaris.

Galago's rate is inclusive of a chef who will prepare the food you supply. **Facilities:** Five en-suite, air-conditioned bedrooms sleeping ten people. Fully equipped kitchen. Indoor and outdoor cooking facilities. Swimming pool. Game Viewing vehicle with a Ranger and Tracker. Serviced rooms and kitchen.

Rates Include: Fully serviced and equipped camp. Two safaris (game drives) per day. One guided bush walk per day.

TUMBETA HOUSE

The camp is an exclusive private camp, self-catered and fully serviced. All food and beverage requirements should be supplied by the guests. Tumbeta's rate is inclusive of a chef who will prepare the food you supply. **Facilities:** Three en-suite, air-conditioned bedrooms sleeping six people. Fully equipped kitchen. Indoor and outdoor cooking facilities. Swimming pool. Game Viewing vehicle with a Ranger and Tracker. Serviced rooms

Rates Include: Fully serviced and equipped camp. Two safaris (game drives) per day. One guided bush walk per day.

CHILDREN: Children of all ages are welcome at Djuma Private Game Reserve. Babysitters are available by advanced request.

PAYMENT: 50% non refundable deposit to be made within 15 days from date of you making the reservation is required to confirm your reservation. Full payment of 50% balance is required 4 weeks (30 days) prior to arrival. No booking is confirmed until the 50% deposit has been received. We accept all credit cards except Diners Club.

CANCELLATIONS: Our cancellations policy is as follows: 2 months (60 days / 8 weeks) prior to arrival 50% of full amount, 1 month (30 days / 4 weeks) prior to arrival 100% of full amount.

ARRIVAL / DEPARTURE: Guests may arrive any time from 14:00pm, and rooms are to be vacated by 10:00am.

SABI SAND ENTRY FEE AND CONSERVATION CONTRIBUTION INITIATIVE:

Entrance into the Sabi Sand Reserve is charged per vehicle and per person. A new conservation Project is being launched in the Sabi Sand Wildtuin across all lodges. It is called the Guest Conservation Contribution Initiative. A conservation fee will be added to our guests' accommodation invoice at an additional cost per person, per nights. The funds accumulated by the lodge, will then be transferred into the Sabi Sand Nature conservation Fund at the end of each month. The funds will be used to support the on-going Sabi Sand anti-poaching projects, as well as to support neighbour relations and ecological initiatives.

WHAT TO TAKE: Comfortable walking shoes, sun hat, sunglasses, sun block, cameral and neutral clothing, swimming costume, warm jackets are essential in winter (May – October). Recommend consulting your GP regarding malaria prophylaxis.

DISTANCES: Johannesburg to Djuma \pm six hours (\pm 500km). Nelspruit to Djuma \pm three hours (\pm 250km).
