The Committee of The Provincial Grand Charity – ‘The Tom Langton Fund’ - meeting on Tuesday 30th April 2019 considered 43 applications from Lodges across the Province of which all bar one were approved, totalling £14230. The Grants will help numerous non-Masonic Charities supporting vulnerable people, including those with disabilities, disadvantaged children, youth organisations, local churches and associations. At this Meeting the Fund reached £776,905 in Grants since it was established in 1985 and over 1521 Charities and deserving causes have benefited as a result.
