Therefore, each year we send out a comprehensive questionnaire to existing and new clients and we have set a target of 86% satisfaction for this year following last years excellent result of 84%.


This is one of the conditions and measurements within the ISO9001 Quality Assurance which we have achieved accreditation year on year since 2003.

A year has passed since achieving accreditation last December and a lot has been achieved by cooperation and enthusiasm by the company personnel and our supply chain. Since early this year **Natasha Austin** has been working closely with **Adrian Mitchell** as Environmental Coordinator. Targets and Action Plans have been put in place. The achievements and results from our audit are very encouraging as follows –

- Electricity = 2% saving on our Carbon Emissions
- Vehicle Fuel = 6.6% increase efficiency i.e. MPG
- Recycling = 82% is being achieved by our approved waste disposal companies
- Recycled aggregates are being used by more sites and demolition materials are being segregated
- 95% of waste paper from our offices is being recycled
