Definition of a Fully Functioning PPG (draft)



A fully functioning PPG will...

- 1. Have a Terms of Reference that sets out its clear purpose and organisation structure.
- 2. Have a core group of patients who meet regularly to plan activities and take decisions about the work of the PPG.
- 3. Have records of its meetings that are made available to all patients.
- 4. Use a range of communication channels to gather patients' views and feedback on services and experiences.
- 5. Be a genuine partnership between the practice and its patients with a shared vision, where there is positive support and encouragement from senior clinicians and sufficient administrative support from the practice.
- 6. Be patient-led (i.e. the chair or equivalent should be a patient of the practice) but with both patients and practice on an equal footing, working together to seek improvements in practices' services and in patients' health and well-being.
- 7. Work inclusively to ensure the interests and views of all patients are adequately represented and taken into account.
- 8. Develop links wherever appropriate with local communities.
