The Royal Marines team up with Browning for Charity Clay Shoot

Building on the success of the previous charity clay shoots Browning are delighted to once again sponsor the third annual Royal Marines Association Clay shoot.

The event is being held over 2 days – 6^{th} and 7^{th} October 2017 at Dunkeld Park Estate, Perthshire.

The first day – 6th October – is the 3 gun team simulated challenge where each team will be joined by a member of the Royal Marines to shoot over 5 different simulated game flushes – Grouse, Partridge, Duck, Pheasant and the sneaky Fur 'n' Feathers stand. A private auction lunch will finish the day off including prize giving ceremony and a performance by the Royal Marines Band Scotland, Corps of Drums

The second day -7^{th} October - is for individuals who will shoot a specially designed sporting round of 50 clays with re-entry encouraged with many distinctive prizes for each category. A unique "High Value" prize will be awarded to the first Straight 100 achieved over consecutive rounds.
