SURFACE TEMPERATURE:

All surfaces to be treated must be structurally sound and existing coatings, adhesives, efflorescence should be removed to achieve maximum bond strength and resistance to hydrostatic pressure. Surfaces must be cleaned free of dirt, Grease, oil or other surface contaminants. Holes, non-structural cracks or other surface deformities should be repaired

PRIMING:

Adcrete membranes are recommended to be applied onto primed surfaces. The following products can be used: Adflex WBP 20L Adflex WBE 20L Kit Experienced applications may use: Rimseal Polybond 20L

APPLICATION:

- Apply product at 2 or more coats and at a total coverage of 1.5-2L/m², forming a dried film thickness of approximately 1.5mm (vertical 0.8mm).
- Adflex Ultra can be applied with a brush or roller
- Allow 24 hours drying before tiling or topping application. In cool or non-porous surfaces this may be prolonged.
- Allow to cure for at least 5 days if water ponding test is required.
- At all junctions apply bond breaker or fast cure mastic filler
- At all junctions embedded polyester/rubber reinforcing tape into membrane.
- Do not apply when surface temperature is below 5°c or above 35°c

OVERCOAT:

Allow at least 4 hours curing time depending on the weather

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PRECAUTIONS:

- During conditions of low temperature of high humidity, the Adflex Ultra curing rate will slow dramatically
- Adflex Ultra Dark Grey is less UV stable then the Light Grey due to heat absorption
- Avoid applying over any surfaces that have been previously coated or treated with curing compounds, concrete bonding agents or acrylic coatings. These must be mechanically cleaned by grinding to produce a contamination free surface.
- Do not apply to areas subject to heavy foot traffic in commercial environments or vehicular traffic.
- Do not apply to areas when rain is imminent

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS:

Adflex Ultra is a safe water-based product however, avoid contact with skin and eyes. Use protective gloves. Ensure there is adequate ventilation and avoid breathing vapours. Keep away from children. If swallowed do not induce vomiting. Give plenty of milk and water. Seek medical advice. Keep containers in a wellventilated place. In enclosed areas, such as water tanks and basements, ventilation should be provided to enable adequate evaporation of the coating.
