- Complying with the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 and relevant legislation and, where practical, with codes of practice, industrial standards and other requirements, such as those specified by our clients.
- Providing appropriate information and supervision to ensure that personal responsibilities are discharged in a safe, reliable and competent manner.
- Providing adequate funding and resources that contribute towards a safe and healthy working environment.
- Maintaining management systems to meet the requirements of the CITB Construction site safety procedures.
