

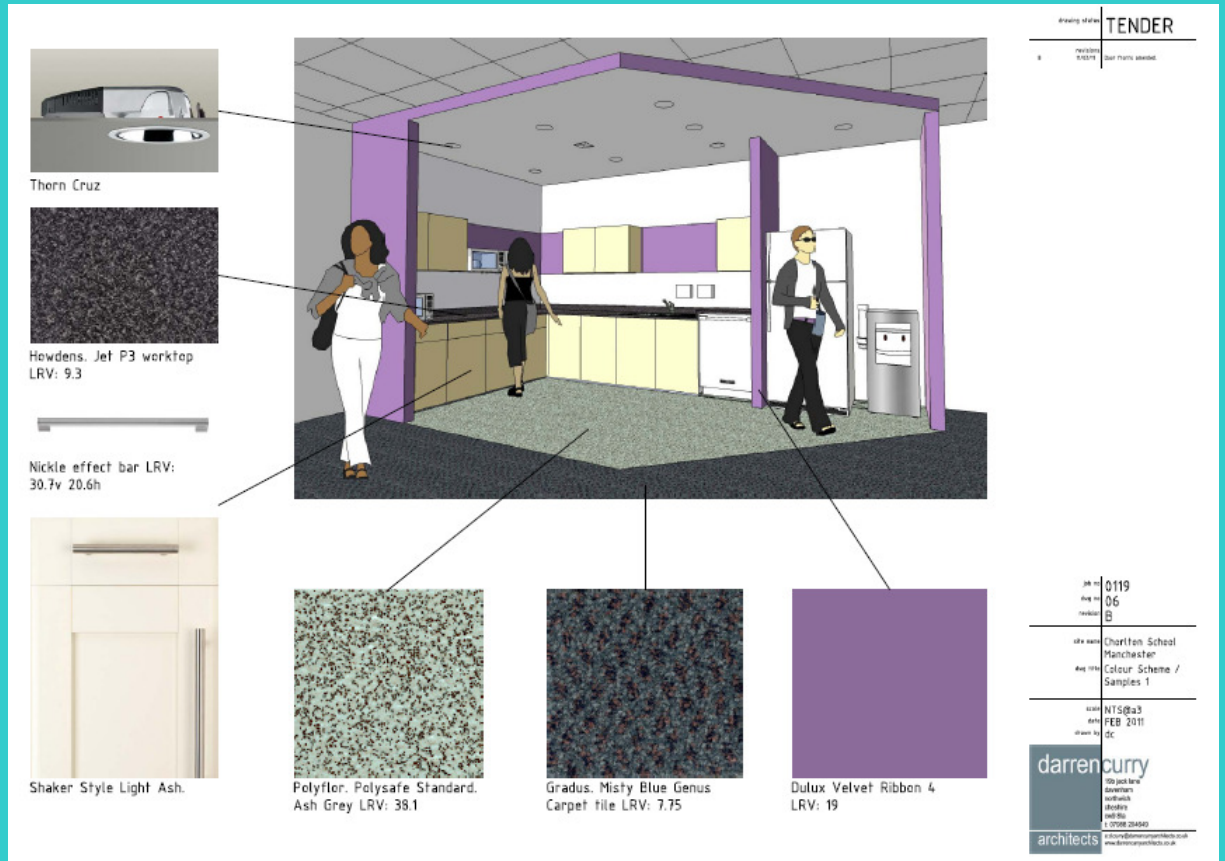
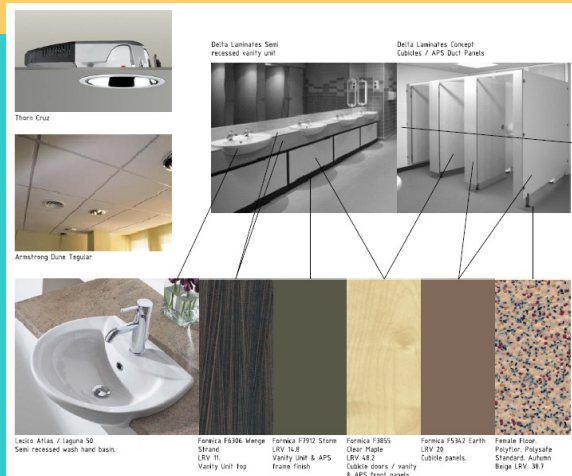
Chorlton School staff toilets
