#### PSA in the Health Sector

The PSA is organising for a high-functioning public health system that is appropriately funded and resourced to provide rewarding careers and safe and healthy workplaces for the people that provide these services for our community.

- Equal Pay Campaign Pay Equity claims have been lodged for DHB Administration workers, Allied, Technical and Scientific workers, and Mental Health and Public Health Nurses. A petition in support of the Administration claim with over 12,500 signatures was presented to Parliament in April 2019. Negotiations are continuing for all three claims.
- Mental Health Inquiry the PSA Yes We Care campaign was instrumental in getting the Government to launch the Mental Health Inquiry. Our PSA Mental Health & Addictions Committee presentation to the Panel ensured that workforce issues and needs were highlighted.

By joining the PSA and participating in campaigns and collective bargaining, you can help us continue to improve wages and conditions for all workers.
