Norte Chico Sauvignon Blanc (Chile)

A very fresh style of Sauvignon Blanc from Chile. Intense aromas of cut grass and nettle with a zesty palate and racy acidity.

Domaine de Pellehaut, Vin de Pays de Cotes de Gascogne

(France)

A delightfully crisp white wine, showing bright lemony fruit aromas followed by green apple, lemon and a touch of herbaceous flower on the palate. Very clean and fresh.

Pinot Grigio, Principato (Italy)

Delicious. Light fragrant wine from Italy, wonderfully fruity.

William's Well Chardonnay Reserve (Australia)

Lovely, full rich Aussie Chardonnay with a very ripe bouquet and a mass of tropical fruit and oak flavours on the palate.

Cotes du Rhone Blanc, Domaine de la Bastide (France)

A blend of Viognier, Roussane and Grenache Blanc which is dry, soft and quite creamy with a hint of fennel.

Petit Bourgeois, Sauvignon Blanc (France)

Wonderfully pungent and aromatic Sauvignon Blanc. From just outside the Sancerre region. Crisp and dry with a distinctive flavour of gooseberries and asparagus.

Gavi La Battistina (Italy)

This wine displays a great freshness, elegance and balance with a nice body. Notes of golden apples, dry spices, pears and figs.

Sauvignon Blanc, Makutu (New Zealand)

A crisp white herbal and zesty New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc, dry and bursting with classic New Zealand tropical flavours.

Gruner Veltliner “Johann” 2006 (Austria)

Aromas of floral spice and citrus, flavours with are spicy, fruity and minerally, just a hint of white flower and pepper.

Verdelho, Margan Family Vineyards (Australia)

Single vineyard Verdelho which has a perfumed, tropical fruit nose with a rich palate, crisp clean finish and a touch of spiciness.

Marques de Caceras White Rioja

An attractive straw colour and an intense bouquet with charming notes of minerals, white flowers and a hint of apple and citrus fruits. In the mouth it is crisp, fresh and clean with delicious fruit flavours that linger on the palate.

Chablis, Domaine de Vauroux 2005 (France)

Very stylish Chablis that is typically dry and flinty with citrus flavours on the finish.

Sancerre, Les Baronnes, Domaine Henri Bourgeois (France)

Delicious, aromatic Sauvignon Blanc from the Loire Valley; crisp and grassy with a lovely bite of acidity.

Pazo Senorans, Albarino (Spain)

100% Albarino with rich, peachy fruit. Aromas of quince, subtle pear and pineapple. Classic balance and a fresh finish.

Thomas (France)

Classic Cote D'Or Burgundy from a lesser known appellation adjacent to Meursault. Complex and refined with a delightfully elegant style

Red Wines

Norte Chico Merlot (Chile)

This is mind-bogglingly full, supple and ripe with really concentrated fruit flavours reminiscent of something altogether more glamorous.

£11.50

Rioja Tinto, Vino Marro (Spain)

Supple blackberry and wild plum notes, rounded out with clean vanilla notes from the delicate use of oak.

William's Well Shiraz Reserve (Australia)

Wonderfully spicy, soft and easy-to-drink. Western Australian red, full of sweet, ripe fruit.

Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Convivio (Italy)

Rich, powerful and complex with flavours of dark berry fruit, bitter chocolate and spice. Soft tannins and just a hint of oak.

Cotes du Rhone Rouge, Domaine de la Bastide (France)

A round soft blend of Syrah, Grenache, Carignan and Mourvedre with a lovely nose of confit fruits.

Nieto Senetiner, Malbec (Argentina)

On the nose, rich strawberry and blackberry predominate. Spectacular berry aromas are nicely rounded out with cherry and oak spice. Surprisingly gentle, balanced and smooth.

Chianti. La Pieve (Italy)

Delicious juicy Chianti – dark and intense with a gorgeous concentration of black cherry flavours and a hint of spice.

Pinotage, Horse Mountain (South Africa)

Frankly the best Pinotage we have ever tasted. Notes of black cherry, chocolate and spice on the nose which follow through nicely onto the palate. Powerful yet elegant.

Marques De Caceras Rioja

This wine has a bright, ruby red colour and an intense bouquet of red fruit. Delicious and lush fruit flavours come through in the mouth with a very pleasant fullness and soft tannins.

Rioja Reserva, Vino Marro (Spain)

Intensely dark nose full of macerated fruits of the forest and some spicy oak. The palate is rich and full with additional notes of chocolate and leather.

Fitou Cuvee, Ancestrale 2005 (France)

Seductive and stylish Carignan 60%, Grenache noir 40%. Great nose, complex with multi-layered fruit. Round and soft in the mouth, intense fruit and great freshness.

Bourgogne Rouge, Nicolas Potel (France)

A very serious Bourgogne Rouge, aromas of cherry and berry fruit, the palate is also packed with cherry but add just a little earthiness and a hint of spice.

£18.00

Cabernet Sauvignon, Grant Burge (Australia)

The elegant palate has generous dark berry fruits and savoury leather flavours, well structured tannins and integrated French oak. It has an excellent weight and persistence and a memorable finish.

Gigondas, Domaine du Pesquier (France)

A very well-balanced wine with aromatic notes of coffee, chocolate and caramel, along with sweet dark fruits, this is beautifully rounded and wonderfully elegant.

Chateau Fourcas Dumont, Lustrac 2003 (France)

A very impressive nose of wild fruit and blackberry, some gamey notes along with a hint of toastiness. On the palate it is very smooth, well balanced with a lovely velvety freshness.

Volnay, Michel Lafarge 2001 (France)

This is beautifully perfumed Burgundy produced by the ex mayor of Volnay from a selection of vineyards within Volnay. The soft red fruit is delicious while the fine tannins add an elegant structure and balance.
