

English

In English we shall be using the stories 'James & the Giant Peach, The Paperbag Princess' to help develop our skills in effectively describing a character. Our poetry and non-fiction writing will be linked to the T4W story and our topic.

The children's SPaG skills will continue to be developed during our daily spelling, phonics and 'basic skills' sessions. We will continue to develop our reading & comprehension skills a range of texts during our guided reading sessions.

History

As Historians we will be using timelines, pictures, texts and first person accounts to develop our understanding and knowledge of events in English history, focusing on The Great Fire of London and The Gunpowder

MFL (Y3)

We shall be learning basic greetings and how to count to 20 in Spanish.

Music

Our singing and composing linked to 'Carnival of Animals.'

Mathematics

The key areas this term are: developing our understanding of place value, addition & subtraction, multiplication & division and fractions.

The children's number skills and facts recall will continue to be developed during daily 'basic skills' & our 'Friday 'Ladder Club' & 'TT Rockstars' sessions.

Science

As Scientists the children will investigate 'Living Things and their Habitats' – considering how a habit provides the basic needs of living things. We will be also investigating the uses of everyday materials and their properties and identifying how they can/or cannot be changed.

Geography

As Geographers we will look at the location of our capital city London and other capital cities in the UK and Europe. We will also develop our knowledge and use of geographical language and features.
