

English

In English we will be exploring the story of 'Supertato' and 'Elliot, midnight superhero'; developing our descriptive writing, especially setting and openings. We will be using the 'Talk for Writing' approach (T4W) to develop our skills as writers. They will develop their knowledge of a range of interesting varied texts including persuasion writing and poetry.

Mathematics

In maths the children will develop their understanding of place value. They will also explore key areas in maths such as numbers, multiplication and division and shape.

Number and reasoning skills will continue to be developed through our daily basic skills sessions.

Science

In Science we will be looking at materials. We will be identifying a variety of everyday materials, looking at their properties and grouping them. We will be exploring which material will conduct electricity. We will be investigating what material will make the best superhero cape.

Art and Design

Following on from last terms focus of colour we will be looking at the work of different artists including Kandinsky. We will be consolidating our colour work by using colour to create shape in our art pieces.

History

In History we will be looking at real life superheroes including Florence Nightingale and Christopher Columbus. We will be looking at the main events in their life and sequence them. We will also look at the difference between past and present.
