Lodges, chapters, etc. still in existence are in most cases indexed under their modern titles, numbers, and Constitutions, and listed alphabetically under the appropriate heading. Cross-references are made where appropriate. *Passim* (e.g. 20–35 *passim*) conveys that the subject is referred to not continuously but in scattered passages throughout the pages; q stands for ‘quoted’; n refers to footnotes, and bibl. to bibliography, if included. Other abbreviations used: Ch – Chapter; D – Deputy; Dist – District; GL – Grand Lodge; GO – Grand Orient; GE – Grand East; GM – Grand Master; GMM – Grand Master Mason; KT – Knight(s) Templar; L – Lodge; Pr (or Prov) – Provincial; RA – Royal Arch; SGComdr – Sovereign Grand commander; SC – Supreme Council. *AQC* refers to *Ars Quatuor Coronatorum, Transactions of the Quatuor Coronati Lodge*.
