

The Senior Living Spectrum




This bubble graph shows how different types of senior care overlap and the relationship between the level of care and the cost.

Near Term Market Dynamics

- The National Investment Center for Seniors Housing & Care (NIC) reports US senior housing occupancy trends softening
- Within the trend there is a large spread in occupancy levels across major US markets depending on local zoning, regulations and demographics.
- New construction starts also hit their lowest levels since 2014 suggesting a possible slowdown.






Long Term Market Dynamics

- ARA National Seniors Housing Group predicts existing supply will need to increase by about 60%
- Aging of the baby boom generation could fuel a 75 percent increase in Americans ages 65 and older in nursing homes, to about 2.3 million in 2030 from 1.3 million in 2010
- Demand for elder care will also be fueled number of Americans living with Alzheimer's disease, which could nearly triple by 2050 to 14 million



 Next generation Vitality Wireless Emergency Call Receivers with improved performance, smaller size and lower total cost of ownership








FYE2019 Milestones
