Thank you for joining us on the Andy Mort Tour

Your Start Number can be found in the separately attached Entry List.

Your Start Time is determined by your Start Number, Car No. 1 Starts at 09:31 Subsequent cars start at 1 minute intervals, ie. Car 10 Starts at 09:40 etc.

Please ensure that you have sufficient fuel in your vehicle when you arrive at the Start at West Bradford Village Hall, Grindleton Road. BB7 4TE (Map. Ref. 103/748447). There is fuel available at the Lunch Halt (Map Ref: 98/890 899), reached after approx. 70 miles Please note that there are very few fuel stations on or near the route of the run.

Start Formalities

The Start Venue will be open from 08:00 until 11:00 and re-open at approx 16:30 Buffet due to be available from 18:00 and the Forum begin at 19:00

It is recommended that you arrive at the Start Venue at least one hour before your start time. Firstly, after arrival, please reverse your car into your allocated parking space (By Start Number) within the competitors car park as shown on the start venue plan. The Club Scrutineer will visit each car in turn for inspection. On passing scrutineering, you will be given a Process Card.

Take your Process Card to the Main Hall and the Secretary of the Meeting in order to sign on. (Note: Driver/Co Driver and any passengers must all sign on) You will then be given your personal documentation, consisting of Meal Tickets for breakfast, and evening buffet, your Check Point Record Cards, Road Book and Rally Plates, etc. (SSRs 5f mod)

Please be ready to start at your designated Start Time.

At the start time present your Check Point Record Card to the start marshal, who will sign it as you leave. On the route not every junction is indicated. The correct route follows the obvious "main" road until the inter. mileage from the previous instruction has been completed. You should then be at a junction which agrees with the next instruction.

Whilst following the route you will find that certain points are designated as "Check Points". These will be either unmanned or manned. At the former you will find a board bearing code letters and these must be entered in the appropriate space on your Check Point Record Card. At the latter, the marshal will sign your Check Point Record Card to prove that you arrived at that point, from the correct direction, during the period of your time window. This period will be stated on your Check Point Record Card.

At the finish of the Run all entrants with a "Full House" on their Check Point Record Cards will be entered in a prize draw for various awards.
