

IOSH Directing Safely

This 1 day course is aimed specifically at senior management and outlines their responsibilities and accountabilities for the control of safety in their organisations.

The course should enable directors from small and medium sized enterprises (up to 250 employees) to review policy and strategies and where necessary introduce changes to enhance safety culture in the workplace.

Course Overview

The importance of strategic health and safety management and its interaction with other business systems.

Directors' and employers' statutory duties.

Identifying accident causes and planning for prevention.

The consequences of poor health and safety management.

Employee selection and the effect of human factors.

Consultation and communication with employees.

Performance monitoring for continual improvement of health and safety management.

Have an understanding of the principals of health and safety management at the most senior level

Be able to review policy and strategies and introduce changes to make their organisation safer
