SPOTLIGHT ON SERVICE / GREEN ROOF INSTALLATION

Weatherproofing Advisors were recently appointed by Vinci Facilities management to complete the re-roofing and installation of the first ever green roof on a Shell forecourt based in the UK.

The old roof covering has come to the end of its serviceable life, with water penetrating the building almost every time there was rainfall.

This issue was compounded by the fact that the existing underground drainage could not deal with the capacity of water running of both the flat and canopy roof areas.

With this in mind Weatherproofing Advisors proposed, and installed a green roof system that not only would eliminate the water ingress, but also due Following the successful installation of the green to the ability of a green roof to hold at least 50% of rainfall would eliminate the underground drainage problem.

The design was carried out in conjunction with Dusty Gedge of LivingRoofs.org.

The existing felt roof covering was prepared and overlaid with a new Proteus Cold Melt warm roof liquid applied waterproofing system.

This was then covered with a bespoke Green Roof system, specifically engineered for it Biodiversity credentials including a hay drainage layer and Carbon8 substrate, completed with wildflower and sedum cuttings.

To complete this unique installation a Mushroom Mycelium was introduced into the substrate to significantly increase its capabilities of sequestering Green House Gases.

roof, further 'World First' tests are being carried out by Stirling University to determine exactly how much Green House Gases can be permanently Drawn-down from the atmosphere. This is critical in the fight against Climate Change.

Finally, a nearby resident overlooking the site has already commented that it is a wonderful thing and will be a lot better to look at than a typical roof covering.
