GENERAL WATERING SCHEDULE

START TIME:

Plants only use water during daylight hours. The best time to start watering is at daybreak (4:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m.). This allows for maximum use of water.

WATERING SCHEDULE GUIDELINES

If the temperature is:

60-69 degrees F

70-79 degrees F

80-89 degrees F

90-99 degrees F

100+ degrees F

Then water this often:

1 Day Per Week

2 Days Per Week

3 Days Per Week

3-4 Days Per Week

5-6 Days Per week

SMALL SPRAY-TYPE HEADS

Water 10-20 minutes each time, depending on exposure and coverage

LARGE STREAM-TYPE HEADS

Water 30-60 minutes each time, depending on exposure and coverage

SAVE WATER

After rainy periods, don't turn sprinkler clocks back on for several days; always wait until lawn begins to need water.
